Project 3000 for Brandenburg launched!

NGG bargaining commission adopts demands that would finally value skilled labour and training in the hospitality industry. Employers call this dubious!

The Commission demands that for the future, wages for skilled workers in the hospitality industry in Brandenburg should be at least € 3,000 gross per month. All other tariff groups should receive an increase corresponding to the percentage increase in the skilled workers group.

The hotel and catering industry must finally transition into an industry with good working conditions. This also includes a proper income, which must be significantly increased.

We are therefore calling on employers to send a clear signal for the future. Wages must rise to 3,000 euros in the tariff group for skilled workers. All other wages and training allowances must increase by the same percentage as wages in the skilled labour group.

DEHOGA, the employers' association, informed us in writing before negotia-

tions began: Our demands are "dubious" and "not feasible". DEHOGA is saying they will only start negotiations if NGG reduces its demands. We will not do that.

Our request to you:

This ambitious but justified demand can only be enforced with the help of the employees themselves. Complain-

ing and moaning will not help. Only strong trade unions are able to regulate good working conditions.
